

GUIDANCE FOR THE NOVEMBER CONCERTS

FOR CHOIR MEMBERS

We are really looking forward to our first concert for nearly two years, as we hope you are. We appreciate that Covid is still with us. We hope that the arrangements below will make the concert as safe as possible.

Before the concert

Please make every effort to sell tickets, and ensure that those who buy them are aware of the guidance for audience members.

Please indicate whether you plan to sing at the concert as soon as the lists are available. Please do this when you register as you come into Church. We hope to have the lists available from 1st November. This will help us plan the best layout for the choir.

We recommend you take a lateral flow test on the morning of the concert.

Please do not attend if you have tested positive for Covid, or you have been asked to self-isolate or are feeling unwell.

As usual, we will need volunteers to erect the stage on the morning of the concert, before the afternoon rehearsal.

At the concert

Please leave coats etc in the Parish Centre before entering the Church.

Please wear a mask when moving around the Church.

Please move straight to your seat in the choir as soon as you enter the Church.

We will be leaving the doors open to increase ventilation, so please dress appropriately.

There will be no interval. There will be a short break and we ask you to stay in your place, unless you need to use the toilets.

At the end of the concert, leave your music on your seat for collection by the Librarians.

We need volunteers to dismantle the stage. This will have to start once the audience and other choir members have left, so we are asking everyone not involved to leave the church as quickly as possible.
